The TOK Presentation

- Will start the week of the 27th of October.
- Approx 10 minutes per person, **maximum of 30 minutes in total**
- Opportunity to do really well – students tend to score better in the Presentation than the Essay



The TOK Presentation...IB Language

- The purpose of the TOK Presentation is to provide students with a topic that interests them and examine the Knowledge Issues involved in that topic. In this way, it is very similar to the TOK Essay, except the TOK Presentation is an oral and interactive method, rather than a written and more passive method.



TOK Presentation - TOK Language

- Choose a real life situation or contemporary problem that you find interesting! TOPIC
- Work out a Knowledge Issue on that topic! KI
- Think which areas of TOK does the KI link to!
W of K and A of K
- Develop and interesting format for your Presentation!



Method

- There can be nothing more boring than sitting through slide after slide of PowerPoint with somebody simply reading out each slide! You should try to use one or two different methods and also be interactive with your audience. These are some suggestions:
 - Videos
 - Handouts
 - Small Games
 - Questionnaires
 - Role Plays
 - Group Work
- You are going to be delivering your Presentations to students so you need to make sure you engage your audience
